

• **Tuition & Fees**

Tuition is \$10/hour (2 hour per class) and is paid at the time of registration. There are 17 classes or weeks for the upcoming semester -- 09 Spring Semester from Jan. 10 to May 30, 2009. The tuition is \$340 per student. **The registration fee is \$15 per semester per student and is non-refundable under any circumstances.** If you register before Dec. 31, 2008, the registration fee will be waived.

• Staff & Teachers

• Students & Classes

FVCS accepts students six years of age and older. Language classes are offered on Saturday morning from 9 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. with one 15 minutes break. Classes will begin on September 6th, 2008 and end on May 30, 2009 (detailed class schedule are written in syllabus) There are three kinds of classes offered in academic year of 08-09: Chinese I, Chinese II, and CSL I (Chinese as Secondary Language).

Chinese I – Age 10 and up. Class is designed for students with limited or no previous Chinese knowledge.

Chinese II –Entry exam needed with no age requirement. This class is designed for students who have previously learned Chinese, due to the different teaching materials, an entry exam is needed to ensure the students are capable to skip Chinese I.

CSL I – Age 6 and up. Class is specially designed for students whose native language is not Chinese or not in Mandarin Chinese. CSL I is targeting the younger students, with the option of parents taking the class with the students.

• Text Books

FVCS teaches simplified version of the Chinese writing, and Mandarin pronunciation in speaking. Our educational materials for all three programs are developed from <Standard Chinese> (Revised Edition) textbooks published by People's Education Press.

• Other Activities

Cultural Classes are available if interests are adequate. Cultural classes are offered after language classes starting at 11:10a.m. Traditional Chinese Dance – Open to all ages. Class will cover basic movement, peacock dance, and variations of Chinese minority dances.

Basic Drawing – Open to all ages. Class will cover basic drawing, cartoon drawing, intro to Chinese painting, and intro to calligraphy.
